Dump Site Mess

When the large roll-off dumpsters were placed at the City Dump Site almost two years ago, the fence to the **burn area** was taken down. This allowed citizens easy access to the burn area. It has come to our attention that many people



are dumping things in this area that are not allowed. This area is for tree limbs, natural unprocessed wood, weeds, lawn clippings, and

garden waste. It is **NOT** for sod, pallets, dirt, concrete, construction materials, garbage, and tires. It is a privilege to have a place to put burnable items. It seems as though this privilege is being abused by many.

The large roll-off dumpsters are for large items such as couches, furniture, mattresses, appliances, etc. Please do not leave large items outside the dumpsters and do not put large items in the small dumpsters. When the large items are placed in the small dumpsters,

they fill up much faster. You can also call the office at (435) 878-2221 and schedule to have these large items picked up curbside at your home.

No construction materials should be placed in any of the dumpsters. If you are building or remodeling, you should have a dumpster at your home for these items.

Please familiarize yourself with the rules. There are some items that are not allowed in the dumpsters. Some of those items are oil, paint, tires, and batteries. Hot ashes and dead animals should also not be placed in the dumpsters. Objects placed in the dumpsters should not protrude out of them.

There are cameras at the dump site and

we will have to issue citations to those that are not following the rules.




