Refrigerator Dumping

Washington County Solid Waste has brought attention to the improper disposal of some of the refrigerators in Enterprise. Appliances that contain Freon are required to have a certificate of evacuation before disposal. This is Federal Law. Fines for violating this law are significant.

There are three appropriate ways to dispose of refrigerators at this time.

The best option is to return the old refrigerator with the company who delivers your new refrigerator. This may cost a small fee.

Second, if you wish to take your refrigerator to the City Dump, the freon must be evacuated first by a certified professional. It must have the certification attached to comply with EPA regulations.

Lastly, you can take your refrigerator to the county landfill, without a certificate of evacuation free of charge.
