Municipal Elections for the City of Enterprise will be held November 7, 2023 to elect persons to the following offices:

**3 City Council Members** (4 Year Term Each)

Candidate filing forms will be available at the Enterprise City Office located at: 375 S. 200 E. in Enterprise, Utah. You may pick them up during normal office hours: 8:00 am-12:00 pm and 1:00 pm-4:30 pm Monday through Friday.

Each person seeking to become a candidate for a municipal office shall file a Declaration of Candidacy **in person** with the City Recorder during regular office hours (8:00 am-12:00 pm and 1:00 pm-4:30 pm) **between June 1, 2023 and not**

**later than 5:00 pm on June 7, 2023.** (USC 20A-9-203). The office will remain open until 5:00 pm on Monday, June 7, 2023.

The Recorder shall review the qualifications necessary to become a candidate and the provisions of statute or municipal ordinance governing the disclosure of campaign contributions or expenditures with each person who files for candidacy. (USC 10-3-208(4); 20A-9-203)

The qualifications for a candidate are:

1. Be a legal United States Citizen;
2. Be at least 18 years old;
3. Be a registered voter of the municipality;

4. Be a resident of the municipality or recently annexed area for a period of 12 consecutive months immediately preceding the date of the election. (USC 103-301; 20A-9-203)

5. If there are more than six (6) individuals who file for the three (3) available Council Member seats, a Primary Election will be held on **Tuesday, August 15, 2023**. If there are less than the above stated number of candidates filing, then no primary election is needed. Voting for the General Election will take place on **Tuesday, November 7, 2023**.

### UTAH OFF-HWY VEHICLE (OHV) EDUCATION REQUIREMENT

New Utah Law requires all OHV operators to complete an OHV education course before operating on public land.

The purpose is to equip operators with awareness of Utah's OHV laws and rules; increase rider safety; promote respectful, sustainable, and on-trail OHV operation;

and promote respect for communities affected by OHV operation.

This course is **required** for **every** OHV operator.

Age 18+

-Free Online Course

-Complete in 15-30 minutes

-Once in a lifetime

-Print or save digital certificate for proof.

Age <18

-Required to take the existing, separate online Youth OHV Safety Course- \$35

-Or, take an approved in-person hands-on skills course and exam.

This began to be enforced on

**WILDLAND FIREFIGHTING SEASON**

The Wildland Firefighting Season began on May 1.

You will begin to see the Full-time Enterprise Wildland Firefighters around more. Make sure to give a warm welcome to these firefighters when you see them. They do a lot for our community by managing the burn pile, maintaining trucks, doing prescribed burns in the area, and being deployed on other wildland fires around the country bring-

ing in income for our community.

These guys are great and we appreciate the work they do for us.

Enterprise City is a rural farming community located in Southwest Utah. The area raises some of the best hay, corn and kids. With several nearby lakes, boating and fishing opportunities are easy to find. Enterprise is the kind of place you like to call home and also like to come home to. The mountains also invite with their scenic beauty, atv and hiking trails, as well as some great hunting. At the end of August, Enterprise City hosts it's annual "Corn Fest", where the whole town turns out to celebrate small town life and the bounty that our local farmers produce.

Pioneer Settlers entered the area in the late 1800's and settled a few miles West of present day Hebron. Those industrious pioneers had a grand plan to build a large dam to help store a sizable amount of water for irrigating their crops during the dry summer season. This allowed them to irrigate far more land and to move farming into the broad valley East of Hebron. Soon a new townsite was plotted and most Hebron residents moved to present day Enterprise.
