**RESOLUTION NO. 2025-007**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND MUNICIPAL COUNCIL SITTING AS THE BOARD OF CANVASSERS ACCEPTING ELECTION RETURNS AND DECLARING AND CERTIFYING THE RESULTS OF THE MUNICIPAL GENERAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 4, 2025.**

**WHEREAS**, the Municipal General Election was held on November 4, 2025; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 20A-4-301 et seq. of the Utah State Code, the City Council and Mayor constitute the Board of Municipal Canvassers for the City of Enterprise and do hereby canvass the returns of the General Election; and

**WHEREAS**, on November 18, 2025, the Board held a duly noticed meeting to canvass the results of the General Election as required by State Code.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Enterprise, Utah, acting as the Board of Municipal Canvassers for the City of Enterprise as follows:

**Section 1:**

- (a) The Enterprise City Council called an Election and directed that it be held on November 4, 2026, as per Utah State Law, for the purpose of electing one (1) Mayor and two (2) Council Members to the City of Enterprise for a term of four (4) years each.
- (b) The Election was duly held as directed by the City Council and the election officials who conducted the election have made and delivered to the City Council, acting as the official Board of Canvassers of the Election, a certificate and return regarding the conduct of the Election, and;
- (c) The City Council, acting as the Board of Canvassers, have reviewed all matters and actions taken relating to the holding and conduct of the Election and is ready to declare the results thereof,
- (d) This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
- (d) A copy of the Canvass will be filed with the Office of Lieutenant Governor for the State of Utah, in conformance with State Law.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the City Council acting in its capacity as the Board of Canvassers (the Board) of the Election, hereby resolves as follows:

**Section 2:** The board hereby finds and determines,

- (a) That the Election was duly and properly called.
- (b) That public notice of the election was published and posted as provided by law.
- (c) That two (2) voting precincts were designated for the Election consisting of all the territory within the boundaries of the City of Enterprise.
- (d) That the Notice of Election prescribed and advertised the time and place of the Election, the polling place, the hours of opening and closing of the polls, the qualifications of voters and other details of the Election.
- (e) That the Election was duly and properly held and the returns there have been made, delivered and canvassed, all in accordance with and as prescribed by the Election law of the State of Utah.

**Section 3:** Pursuant to the canvass of election returns, the Board finds that the following votes were cast by the qualified voters of the City of Enterprise who voted in the Election:

**Section 4:** The City Council, acting as the Board of Canvassers of the election, finds, determines, and declares the results of the Election to be that Brandon Guy Humphries was elected Mayor of the City of Enterprise and that Justin Seegmiller and Kanton Vause were elected to the City Council of the City of Enterprise by a majority of the qualified voters in the city who voted in the Election. The term of each person elected is four years beginning the 1<sup>st</sup> Monday of January, 2026, being sworn in at the first City Council meeting held in January, 2026.
